What is the Goal?

The Rural Route Evaluated Compensation System (RRECS) relies on the Mobile Delivery Device (MDD) scanner to collect specific data in order to establish each rural carrier's evaluation. The MDD has new functionality that tracks Rural Carrier delivery activity. Carriers must correctly apply the respective RRECS Activity scans with the appropriate delivery activity.

What is Required by Carriers Daily?

Carriers must:

- Log into MDD correctly, immediately at start of each workday
- Perform all required scans daily
- Keep scanner with them throughout work performance, even when dismounting
- Scan parcels at the delivery point(s)
- Ensure MDD is properly returned to cradle at end of workday
- Use correct scan for corresponding activity

What is Required by Managers?

Management must:

- Attend required HQ provided training session
- Provide training to all rural carriers within office to include RCAs
 - Ensure carriers understanding of these requirements
- Provide all rural carriers with copy of RRECS Scan Summary Guide
- Review activity scan compliance in RMSS to help in understanding of missed scans.
- Hand out copies as needed to keep carriers informed of these necessities
